Tableland artist Sue Krucker has relocated Full Circle Studio and Gallery to her hobby farm at Yungaburra.

IT WAS a case of life imitating art for Sue Krucker when the local artist settled on her Yungaburra hobby farm as the new location for her Full Circle Art Studio and Gallery.

"Things have worked out great, I could not be happier," Mrs Krucker said.

Situated just 2km from Yungaburra's historical village centre, the studio is

perfectly positioned to entice tourists. "As well as unique, one-off works of art I can now offer spectacular views of Lake Tinaroo and show off a menagerie of farm animals," she said.

Mrs Krucker told the *Tablelander* she wanted to use the studio not only to promote her own art work but the entire region. "I don't sell coffee or food so when visitors stop

in I can direct them other local businesses," she said.

Visitors to the gallery can also see the artist at work creating limited edition linocut prints, mosaics, hand-printed calico bags and key rings.

Mrs Krucker said after relocating Full Circle Art Studio and Gallery twice before she now knew there was no place like home.
